### **OVERVIEW OF THE POSITION**

IDF seeks to hire Nursing–Trainer, to be based out of Ujjain in Madhya Pradesh. The positions report to the concerned Assistant Project Manager and will be a part of a mobile training team, responsible for conducting on-site Comprehensive Contraceptive Care (CCC) training focusing on Intra-Uterine Contraceptive Device (IUCD) training. In addition, the Nursing- Trainers will be responsible for providing ongoing mentoring support to trained providers.

### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The responsibilities of the Nursing–Trainers will include the following:

- Organize and conduct structured, on-site trainings on Comprehensive Contraceptive Care (CCC) with a focus on Intra-Uterine Contraceptive Device (IUCD) to eligible providers at the facility.
- Conduct pre and post training visits to sites, prepare reports as per the organization's requirements and share findings with the team and the concerned Assistant Project Manager.
- Provide on-site post training clinical mentoring support to trained providers to ensure 100% quality service delivery.
- Conduct other structured training, activities to strengthen service delivery by trained providers and sites.

### **QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE**

Candidates suitable for the position:

- Degree in Bachelor of Science in Nursing or Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Post Basic) or General Nursing & Midwifery or Master of Science in Nursing with a major in midwifery.
- A minimum of 5 years' experience of working on reproductive health, preferably in the area of family planning/midwifery.

- Prior experience of working with international and national level NGOs, health departments and public health facilities.
- Prior experience of conducting class room and skill training, Intra-Uterine Contraceptive Device (IUCD) training will be preferred.
- Ability to strategically plan and work in a team.
- Ability to read, write and speak in English and Hindi.
- Ability to travel 70% of the time to district/sub-district/block level program areas.
- Relevant experience from any part of India with a willingness to relocate to Madhya Pradesh.
