Distribution of Corona prevention, Education and Nutrition kits to 280 families in the slum areas of Lalghati, Bhopal

As part of our CSR program, members of IDF distributed COVID-19 prevention kits, education kits and nutrition kits to 280 families living in slum areas of Lalghati, Bhopal in Madhya Pradesh. These families were identified with the help of Kunjal Welfare Society—a local NGO, and Anganwadi workers (AWWs) in the area. The distribution event was attended by several government officials, along with the guest speaker, Professor Vibha Khare (HOD, Home Science Department), Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bairagarh — a prominent girls' college in the area.

The event was also used to educate participants on the importance of nutrition, and ways of maintaining adequate nutrition with the help of easy to make, affordable food.

Distribution of educational material to 80+ children from low-income families, in Delhi

As part of the IDF CSR initiative, members from the Delhi team distributed educational material to 80+ students, from low-income families. These children were identified with the support of Manzil — a youth-led non-profit learning centre in Delhi that provides after-school educational support and resources to enable students to have access to quality education.

The IDF team developed and shared age-appropriate reference material on health and wellness for students aged 10-19 years. They also put together education kits for them, with each kit containing subject books including English, Mathematics and History; stationery for study and art such as pencils, erasers, pens, color pencils, sketch pens, and paints; and a stationery pouch/geometry box.
