What would you be expected to do?

Project Planning and implementation

Responsible for project planning, design and its effective implementation. Develop comprehensive annual work plans for data collection and compilation, identifying resources required and monitoring progress.

• Knowledge management, documentation and dissemination

Work with the team to understand the status of Quality of Care (QOC) within the private sector with special focus on health care facilities. This may include reviewing the various QOC frameworks, outline quality indicators and markers for measuring and benchmarking etc. Synthesize learnings from previous models of engagement with the chosen private sector entity to understand what has worked and what has not. Disseminate the project's knowledge internally and externally with stakeholders. Develop list of recommendations on potential interventions to improve QOC in the private sector.

 External partnerships - Identify and engage with a wide range of private sector partners and stakeholders including donor, FOGSI, marketing agencies and private establishments providing RMNCH support and care to understand perceptions around QOC. Estimate the potential impact of engagement with these providers. Organizing strategic consultation meetings/workshops with key stakeholders/experts and partners.
