About the Consultancy

The consultant's primary responsibility will be to map digital health programs and interventions initiated by the state and central governments since the launch of the National Health Portal in 2014 (and any significant milestone prior to 2014 in digital health). The consultant will provide insights into the goals of these interventions, key stakeholders involved in their design and implementation, the target audience, utilization of these programs, and their current status. The final deliverables will include a detailed report, collated relevant policies and guidelines, and a presentation to the IDF team.

Responsibilities

- 1. Document all digital health programs and interventions launched by the state and central government since 2014 (and any significant milestone prior to 2014 in digital health), including those implemented through public-private partnerships.
- 2. Share how individual programs and interventions complement or overlap with each other, wherever applicable.
- 3. Collect and organize relevant policies and guidelines for each program or intervention.
- 4. Provide online links to resources, including those for program information, policies, guidelines, and nodal and implementing agencies.
- 5. Ensure the collected information is presented in a clear, concise, and easy-to-understand format for stakeholders.
